We used the funding in the following ways	
<p>Swimming: Years 3 and Year 4 go swimming for a term and a half each year. Pupils represented the school at the Newham Mini Games.</p> <p>After school sports clubs: We offer a range of after school sporting activities from Year 1 to Year 6, in multisports, bowling, basketball, athletics, football, karate and street dance. Our pupils regularly attended inter school sports events through the Brampton Manor Trust Partnership.</p> <p>Gymnastics: There is a before school gymnastics club run by two members of staff. Six pupils represented the school at the Newham Mini Games.</p> <p>Girls Football is offered as an after school club. Girls from the school regularly take part in football tournaments with other schools.</p> <p>Lunchtime basketball: This has enabled the school team to take part in the Dennis Hall Memorial cup.</p> <p>Brampton Manor Trust Partnership: Buying into this service provides support for the PE Coordinator. Links with other schools for networking and sporting collaborations outside the partnership. Also opportunities for inter school competitions.</p> <p>Annual Sports day: With the support of additional coaches we were able to run a varied sports programme in school for EYFS, KS1 & KS2.</p> <p>CPD and cover: Qualified coaches' work alongside our staff to improve the provision to the children and raise the standard of PE taught in the school.</p>
