Each year we are more impressed with the confidence of the Reception and Nursery children. Again this year, they have settled in really well, considering how very young they are; so well done Mums and Dads they couldn't have done it without your support in helping them to be well adjusted and independent children.

Let's keep up the good work and remember:

For girls:

- hair bands, clips and ribbons should be in white, navy blue or black
- hair styles should be simple and age appropriate (no coloured hair)
- no nail varnish or make up of any form
- small studs earring or allow but no hoop or dangly earrings
- tights/socks should be black or navy blue

Boys are asked to have their hair trimmed in a sober, age appropriate manner for school so there should be no:

- pony tails, mohawks, coloured hair patches
- no symbols or brand or designs cut into the scalp
- no earrings for school

All children should wear black school shoes no trainers are allowed.

Building Works

Over the summer holidays we were busy improving the structure of the school with some external work to the school entrance to provide a more inviting entrance for our children, families and visitors. In addition, we improved the KS2 quiet area but have some additional work to take place for it to be complete. We have also undertaken work to our nursery building in order to develop a provision to accommodate children from birth. We will update you as the school year progresses about when the provision will open and how you can register any children under three years old for this provision.

Brentwood Catholic Children's Society (BCCS)

Over the last two years St Francis' has been working with Brentwood Catholic Children's Society's counseling service to support children in St Francis'. We live in an ever challenging world where families and children may come across difficulties that they need support to address. BCCS provides trained counselors that can work with children in a one to one confidential environment during the school day. If your child has suffered bereavement, anxiety, etc. please speak to your child's class teacher about how you can access this private and confidential support during the school day.

Eat For Free

The Mayor of Newham Sir Robin Wales has made a commitment to fund the Eat for Free programme for children in years 3-6 with no additional costs to parents or to the school. As a result, **school meals in years 3-6 will remain free.**

Curriculum Meetings
