### **English**

This term we will be looking at poems and stories. We will be reading the Books 'The Diary of a Killer Cat and 'The Puffin book of first poems.

#### Topic

Our topics for this term are Oceans and Seas in Geography and Travel and Transport in History. Through lively and interesting activities the children will build their knowledge of oceans and seas around the world. They will begin to understand the different environments these represent and how they affect life on land as well as at sea. They will develop their geographical skills and build up their knowledge of food chains, exploration, and evolution! In History they will learn about the development of travel and transport throughout history. Alongside consolidating their understanding of chronology through using timelines and making comparisons between old and new forms of transport, we will focus on early travel methods of the Vikings, through to the invention of cars, trains and aeroplanes.

### Computing



Children will learn to explore about programming covering a unit titled "we are astronauts". They will also test different games and see how they work. They will share their favourite games with the class.



Children will learn how to say their birthday in French as well as all the months of the year. They will also be learning how to ask for some food in a shop.



## Homework

Children are expected to complete their own homework, however, parents need to sign it before it is handed in to confirm that homework is of an acceptable standard.

Homework is given out on **Friday** and is due back on **Tuesday**. Remember homework is to be completed in homework books (not in the worksheet we send).

If homework is not returned on Tuesday it will not be marked before the next week's homework is given.
