We will name body parts and learn how to draw the human



Homework

Children in Reception will take handwriting homework on a regular basis. Please support them to hold their pencil correctly whilst forming the letters.

We also encourage you to help your child by counting and recognising numbers to 10 and practising the sounds they have learnt in school.

This term children in reception will be concentrating on looking and listening to different types of music. Gradually they will be encouraged to join in.
