English

Topic

Our topics for this term are an Monarchs in History and Rivers and canals in Geography. Children will compare the lives and reigns of Elizabeth 1 and Queen Victoria, two fascinating monarchs. Place their reigns and significant events within a chronological timeline. Identify the key roles of a monarch and further learning about these fascinating characters through a range of exciting and interactive activities. In geography children will carry out an investigation to find out how rivers begin and develop. Journey down a river, create rivers and canals and discover the differences. Discover the significance of rivers and canals in industry, and investigate weaving.

Computing



Children will learn to explore about programming covering a unit titled "we are astronauts". They will also test different games and see how they work. They will share their favourite games with the class.



Children will learn how to say their birthday in French as well as all the months of the year. They will also be learning how to ask for some food in a shop.

Homework

Children are expected to complete their own homework, however, parents need to sign it before it is handed in to confirm that homework is of an acceptable standard.

Homework is given out on **Friday** and is due back on **Tuesday**. Remember homework is to be completed in homework books (not in the worksheet we send). If homework is not returned on Tuesday it will not be marked before the next week's homework is given.
