English


Children will enjoy reading a variety of non-fiction and fictions texts.

Children will learn about healthy eating, the importance of exercise and basic hygiene. They will learn how to put these practises into their daily routine.



This term children in reception will be concentrating on exploring the different sounds. They will have an opportunity to make up simple songs and rhythmic patterns.
