In Spring we are continuing with our RWI phonics programme. Children are learning to use their sounds to read and write words as well as learning to read and spell common words easily.

Big Write

In Big Write lessons children explore story writing and how to improve their work.

Maths

Year 1 will be practising counting up to and beyond 20, ordering up to 20, mental addition and subtraction and will be introduced to place value. We will also be investigating shapes and standard measures and will begin to count in 2s, 5s and 10s. Every week children will get the opportunity to apply their maths knowledge and skills through solving a puzzle or problem.


For RE lessons we will continue with **Come and See** as our scheme of work.

PE


Please ensure that your child brings appropriate PE kit on the correct day.

History & Geography

Computing



Computing lessons this term will support the Art curriculum. Children will use web search engines to collect pictures by different artists. They will also explore ways in which those pictures can be organised. Children will become aware of how to use technology safely.

PSHE



Children will explore the theme "Going For Goals" they will highlight the importance of having goals and how they can work to achieve them. This will help to develop their growth mind-set.
