
Year Group and Staff

English

This term we will be using 'The Adventures of Odysseus' and 'Seasons of Splendour' in our English lessons. These books will be used to develop skills in writing narratives, myths and legends, reports and arguments



We will continue to develop our reading and writing skills through our comprehension, writing and Big Write sessions.

Maths



The children will be learning about numbers and our number system and developing mental and written methods for calculation.

We will also be extending our understanding of fractions, decimals and percentages, along with geometry and Statistics.

Science

Over this term Year 5 will be learning why living things need to reproduce. We will explore in detail the human life cycle, comparing it with other animals.

The School Nurse will visit to talk to the children about the physical and emotional changes during puberty.


R.E.
