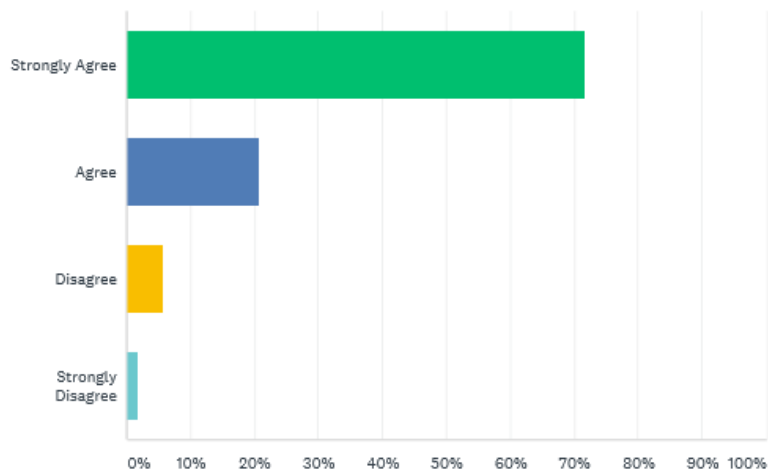

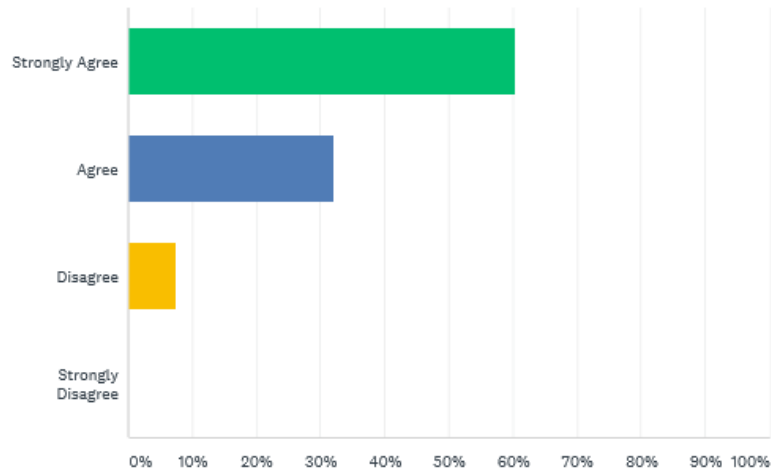

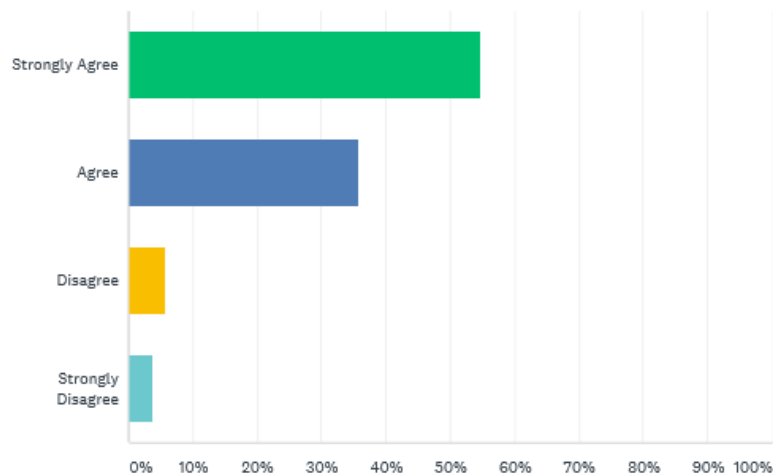

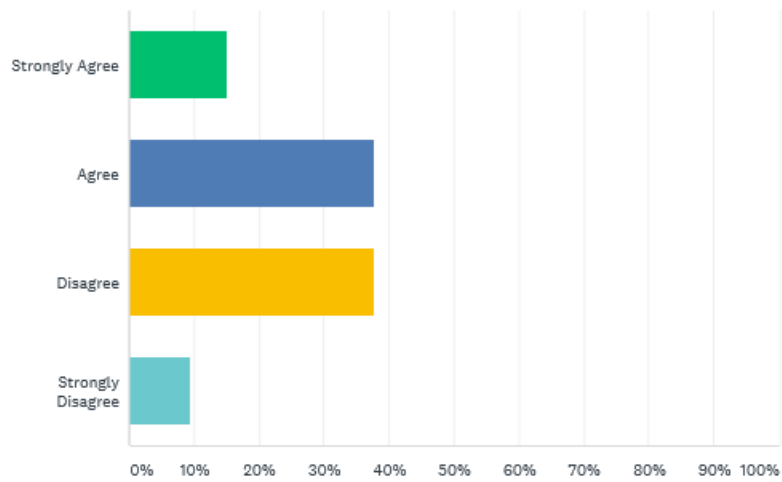

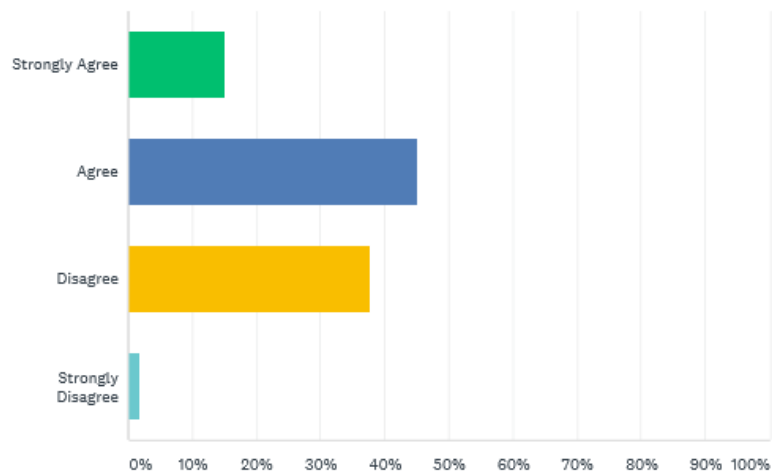

As a mother with another baby in the pram sometimes is it not possible to enter school gate because of cars parking straight in front of the gate.

I strongly think there should be a zebra crossing by the school opposite the car wash. It's hectic and nerve racking for even an adult to cross the very busy road without the assistance of the Lolly pop support. Some Patents are still inconsiderate not abiding by the markings whilst dropping and picking, endangering life's of children walking to and from school. Perhaps traffic enforcement officers should be on duty there at these times.

Results of On-line Road Safety Questionnaire

Question 1, 5 and 9 are not relevant to everyone and ambiguous therefore should have another way to answer. Pick up and dropping children at St Francis Catholic Primary School is really difficult and not safe as parents are careless when parking. Most of them (parents) would rather put children's safety at risk by parking on the yellow zigzag lines than park somewhere safe and walk the very short distance to school. I would suggest that you go and see what Coldgrave School is doing during this busy time of dropping and pick up. I think they have some made-up figurines or posters that they put on the yellow zigzag lines to prevent parents parking on them and ensure children's safety when using the road around the school at those busy times.

Really glad that the children came up with this really relevant and important issue that they are facing regarding their safety at school. This shows that the school leaders and governors are really concerned and love the children that they have been trusted to care for. Thank you for this opportunity that you are giving everyone to help and bring ideas to resolve this issue.

I allow my son to walk home but I sometimes get worried about the travel on the bus or the walk from school to the bus stop on Romford Road given the increasing knife crime issues. However, I think there are sufficient zebra crossings that my son can access. I would like the school to continue to emphasise especially that they must look and wait for the vehicles to stop before stepping into the crossing. Thank you.

Concerning dropping off kids in school with a car is a kind of battle with other parents with cars. Some are inconsiderate to others. Please, this issue should be tackled as soon as possible.

Definitely, next to school needs a traffic light, because after school club, difficulty crossing the road.

The school zebra crossing opposite the gate on Bow Street is not easy to cross.
