R.W.I



During the Summer Term some Year 1 children will consolidate their RWI phonics programme with a focus on transferring their knowledge of sounds to help them spell new words.

English

The rest of the children will have English lessons where they will be exploring books such as *Mr Underbed*, *Where The Wild Things Are* and *The Jolly Postman*. The children will be inspired to write stories, letters and participate in roleplays.

Maths

During the summer term Year 1 will be consolidating their understanding of number and place value and learning how to apply it.

We will also learn about mental multiplication and division which we will in turn relate to fractions.

We will learn to measure accurately weight, capacity and length and explore geometry: properties of shapes, position and direction.



Science



Plants and Seasonal changes

Children will learn about the different parts of plants and their functions as well as being able to identify local flowers. We will link this to the changes that occur in plants over the seasons and explore the reasons for these.


In RE lessons we will continue with **Come and See** as our scheme of work.

In PSHE lessons the children will be exploring how we meet God's love in our family. They will also look at new beginnings towards the end of the term as they approach the end of year 1.




Homework
