Dear Parent/Carer,

We began our wider re-opening this week and now have a group of year 6 children and a group of year 1 children in school along with the key worker children.

We are now ready for the return of the children in Reception on Monday, 15th June. Thank you to all the parents that have confirmed that their Reception child will be attending. **The hours of school remain the same 8:45 – 3:15, however there will be no Breakfast Club and Tea Time Club provisions. Each child should have a water bottle with them to be able to drink water throughout the day as the water fountains in the playground have been turned off for hygiene reasons.**

As you will be aware from my previous letter the school has put a variety of health and safety measures in place including the introduction of a one way system which means that **children and parents need to enter the playground via Bow Street and exit the playground via Maryland Park.** This has been introduced for the safety of all the children and to adhere to the government guidance, therefore we need all parents to follow this system.

Google Classroom will continue to be available for the children at home who are not returning. **For the children who are returning, we will begin preparation for year 1 in addition to the Google Classroom work. In order to support that preparation Mr Kiernan, who will be your child's year 1 teacher, will be taking over the Reception P class when it re-opens on the 15th June. Ms Pikiewicz will continue to be the teaching assistant and Mrs Paul will continue to be available on Google Classroom.**

If you would like your child to attend you need to contact the school to request a place for your child to attend the wider re-opening, you cannot simply bring your child in.

I want to say well done to the parents who have embraced Google Classroom to support their child's learning. We are looking forward to welcoming back some of the Reception children on Monday, 15th June.

As always the well-being and safety of your family continues to be in my prayers.
