

How to access Google Classroom using an Xbox or PlayStation 4

Xbox



Xbox consoles have access to Microsoft Edge, which is the web browser that comes preinstalled on the console. Using Microsoft Edge, you can access Google Classroom.

- Plug in a wired keyboard into your Xbox One/Xbox Series X or Xbox Series S via one of the USB ports on the front or back of the console.
- 2. Go to your *Home* screen and then go into *My Games and Apps*
- 3. Click on, 'See all', and scroll down to 'Apps' and you will see the Microsoft Edge logo () . Select Microsoft Edge.
- 4. Type in <u>classroom.google.com</u> into the address bar at the top
- 5. Using your St. Michael's Google login details (ending with -> @st-michaels.newham.sch.uk) log on to Google Classroom.
- 6. You can either use your Xbox controller to move the cursor or use a separate USB mouse, which can be plugged into one of the USB ports on your console.

PlayStation 4



- 1. Go to the *Library* section on your PS4 and select it.
- 2. Within the *Library*, use the search bar to type in '*Internet*'.
- 3. Select the PlayStation internet browser icon
- 4. Start the Internet Browser and press the triangle button on your controller to search
- 5. In the search box type in- classroom.google.com
- 6. Enter your St. Michael's Google login details (ending with -> @st-michaels.newham.sch.uk) and log on to Google Classroom.

NOTE

- In some cases, you might not be able to do everything you can usually do on a laptop or PC, when using a console to access Google Classroom. However, at the very least, you can access Google Classroom and see what work your teacher has assigned for you to do.
- Using your console controller to type can be difficult
