English This term we will be reading



'There's a Boy in the Girls' Bathroom' by Louis Sachar, then we will be exploring the Greek myth 'Odysseus'. These books will be used to develop skills in writing poetry, diary entries, recounts, reports and persuasive writing.

We will also continue to focus on the development of reading skills through our comprehension sessions, answering



and exploring focussed questions around inference skills and finding information.

Maths

We will be beginning the year by revising essential place value and number facts. We will then be studying time durations as well as written methods for calculations. Finding equivalents between decimals and fractions will be an important topic for us later in the term.

Out of This World

In this unit of study, we will extend our learning about gravity into the solar system, learning about how the Planets and their Moons orbit the Sun. We will also study some of the other planets in our sólar system.

Newton's discovery of gravity as well as studying the uses of friction and air resistance.

<u>Black History</u>: We will explore the arrival of the Empire Windrush in 1948 and learn about the contributions the Windrush Generation and their descendants, have made to British life. This will include focusing on the social aspects of their lives - how they built a sense of community and the challenges they faced.



<u>Geography</u>—Forces of Nature We will learn about the Earth's layers and their properties as well as how volcances are formed. We will also explore the locations of the Earth's volcances and use collage to create pictures of volcances. We will move on to studying rivers, how they are formed and their uses. In addition to this, we will be taking part in an exciting project with a group of professional architects which will involve some workshops, architectural drawing and model making.

Computing



Compu- ting systems and networks –Systems and searching - Learners will develop their understanding of computer systems and how information is transferred between systems and devices.

Creating Media - Video production -Learners will learn how to create short videos by working in pairs or groups.







This term we are continuing to familiarise the children with the 'Zones of Regulation' - enabling them to think about and better control their emotions. We will also be encouraging the children to continue to show a 'Growth Mindset', celebrating and learning from our mistakes.



Homework

Most homework will now be set on Google Classroom, timed to appear for the children at 3:30pm on Fridays. It needs to be completed by before school on the following Tuesday morning and will consist of a Maths task and a Grammar or Comprehension task. It is brilliant when parents support their children with their homework, however all work must be completed and submitted by the children them-

selves. Spellings will also be given each week. Spelling practice should be competed each day of the week in preparation for our spelling test each Friday.

MFL - French

In French, we will be learning to describe people, saying colours that are useful for describing hair and eyes. We will also be learning vocabulary to describe a person's personality and

physical features. Children will be encouraged to speak in French in the classroom.
